**Verse C**

**Verse 2**

Lastly, fill in the little things:  
eyes, a beak, and a bunch of toes, toes!

**Verse 3**  
C is for Camel, bumping bump, bump.  
Start with a C tipped on its side.  
Now you have the camel's big hump.  
Add a head and a neck, oh my!  
Add a short tail to its rump.  
Draw four legs running in stride.  
Lastly, fill in the little things.  
The camel needs ears and an eye, eye, eye!

**Verse 4**  
R is for Rhino, stomping stomp, stomp!  
Start by drawing the letter R.  
R makes the head and front legs.  
For a rhino body, draw a long arc.  
Then draw its two back legs  
and a wagging tail and say, "Charge!"  
Lastly, fill in the little things:  
eyes, ears, a horn, and there you are!
